

Construction Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

The City of Ellinger, TX will receive bids for **Drainage Improvements and Road Reconstruction, CID 02, GLO CDBG-MIT 24-065-130-E988** until June 25, 2026 at 6 p.m. at 101 West Shumacher. Bids must be addressed to: Mayor Matt Mikulenko, City of Ellinger. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud on June 25, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. at 101 West Shumacher, Ellinger, TX.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

- Street Flood and Drainage Improvements including ditch grading, new culverts, surface replacement, complete in place as shown on the drawings
- Street Improvements including grade and chip seal, complete in place as shown on the drawings

Bid/Contract Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications are on file at the City of Ellinger, 101 West Shumacher, Ellinger, TX or www.civcastusa.com.

Copies of the Bid/Contract Documents may be obtained by depositing \$200 with the Engineer for each set of documents obtained. The deposit will be refunded if the documents and drawings are returned in good condition within 10 days following the bid opening. The documents may be obtained electronically (at no cost) from CIVCAST at www.civcastusa.com.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Ellinger or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

A non-mandatory prebid meeting will be held on Thursday May 21 at 1 pm at 101 West Shumacher.

The project to be constructed will be financed with assistance from the General Land Office (GLO) under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant - Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) program and is subject to all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations. Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing Davis-Bacon and Related Acts wage rate, as issued by the Department of Labor and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or national origin. Adherence to the City of Ellinger Section 3 Policy is required for all contracts.

All contractors and subcontractors must be cleared (not suspended or debarred) prior to any formal action authorizing the award of a contract to the contractor. Minority Business Enterprises, Small Business Enterprises, Women Business Enterprises, Section 3 Businesses, and labor surplus area firms are encouraged to submit bids.

The City of Ellinger reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by City of Ellinger for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
